Home – School Communication: eSchools

This half term we are moving all of our home-school communication to eSchools: one easy to access platform. We will gradually migrate all communication across so that by the end of Spring term we will no longer be using Class Dojo or Teachers to Parents text or email. eSchools already host our school website and offer a text and email service similar to the current system we have in place although you will not be able to text back.

We ask that <u>all communication to school</u> comes through the office email <u>piasecretary@pia.celtrust.org</u> or telephone 01208 880494.

Your child will be bringing home a letter on Monday with your login details and instruction on how to access the web based platform and/or how to download the eSchools App. These will be a one stop shop for information about the school: our school newsletter; school calendar dates and any messages or emails that have been sent out.

We will have:

- eSchools website.
- eSchool parent platform- accessed through the login tab on the school website.
- eSchools app- an easy place to find all communication from the school.
- School Facebook page for celebrating learning and events in school.
- Staff emails available.
- Nippers Nursery and Seal Pups Reception will still use Tapestry.
