We have an exciting week planned for our Reception to Year 6 students next week. Here are the details: From Monday to Friday, all children from Reception to Year 6 will be going swimming every afternoon. Please note the following arrangements:

- **Timetable:** We will leave the school at 12:45pm to travel by coach to Camelford Leisure Centre. Swimming sessions will take place from 1:30pm to 2:30pm. We aim to return to school by the end of the school day.
- **Lunch:** Children will have an early lunch at school. Please ensure that you book school dinners on ParentPay as usual.
- **Cricket Session:** Despite the swimming schedule, there will still be a cricket session on Friday morning. Please ensure your child comes in their sports kit on Friday.

Travel and Collection

We are aware of proposed roadworks in the area and hope they will not affect our schedule. However, if collecting your child directly from Camelford Leisure Centre would be more convenient for you, please inform your child's class teacher. You will need to be at the leisure centre by 2:40pm to collect your child.
