You should have received your login details for eSchools as a paper letter in the book bag post.

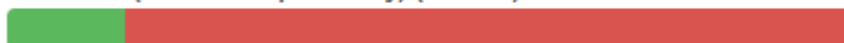

We intend to close the school Class Dojo account on Friday 8th March. Photographs that celebrate learning, both in and outside of school, will be shared on the school Facebook page.


We are cancelling our subscription to Teachers 2 Parents and texts and emails will come from eSchools.

Our aim is be only using eSchools, Tapestry for EYFS and Facebook by the end of term.

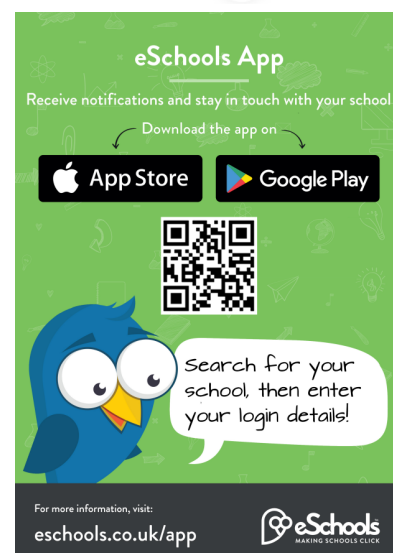
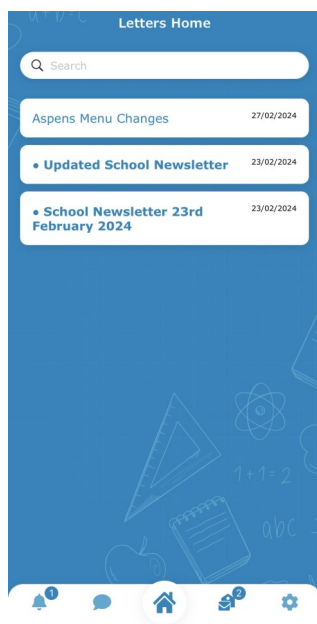
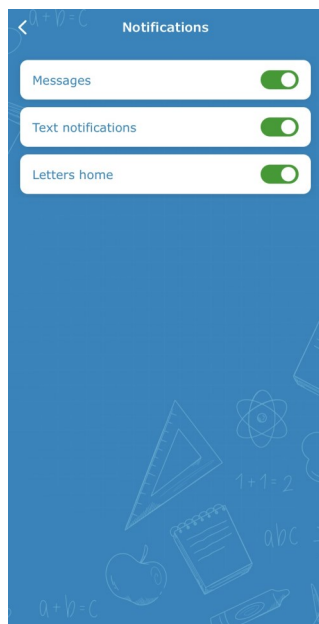
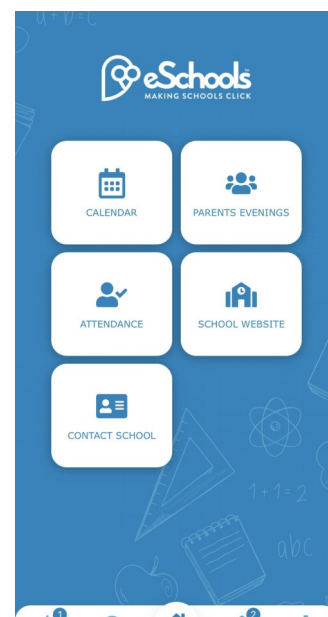
